✓ IMPLEMENT AN ELECTRONIC PRESCRIPTION SOFTWARE

DON'T WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE

Effective March 27, 2016, <u>all</u> prescriptions must be issued electronically. To do so, prescribers must have a software system in place. Electronic prescribing software can be integrated with most electronic patient record software; however, it does not require that the doctor also have an electronic patient record system in the practice. Given that <u>every</u> prescriber statewide is affected, it is crucial that dentists select a software system as soon as possible and begin the implementation process. For those that prescribe controlled drugs, the security verification process and registration with the Department of Health's Bureau of Narcotic Enforcement will require additional time. If you do not have a software system in place, after March 27th you will not be able to prescribe for your patients.

If you have an electronic patient record system, check with your current vendor. NYSDA has partnered with Henry Schein to offer members eRX software at a significant discount. ✓ ESTABLISH AN ONLINE <u>HEALTH COMMERCE SYSTEM</u> (HCS) ACCOUNT REQUIRED TO PRESCRIBE CONTROLLED DRUGS

Do you prescribe controlled drugs? If so, in addition to registering with the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), you must establish an online Health Commerce System (HCS) account with the NYS Department of Health. As part of New York's I-STOP legislation, since August 2013, all practitioners who prescribe or dispense controlled medications are required to query the controlled drug Registry each time they prescribe or dispense a controlled substance, regardless of the amount. To access the Registry, prescribers must establish an online Health Commerce System (HCS) account. Additional information on the HCS online account system is available by calling the HCS account system at either: 866-529-1890, option 1; or 866-811-7957, option 1; or on the Health Commerce System website, https://commerce.health.state.ny.us/. Don't forget, you must query the Prescription Monitoring Program Registry (and document that inquiry) to check your patients' prescription history before prescribing any controlled drug.
